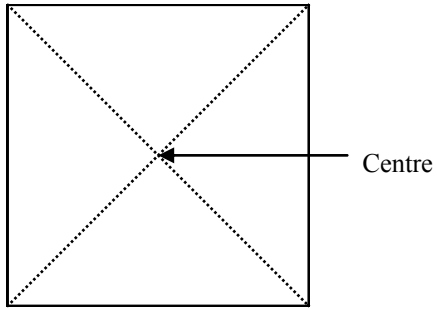
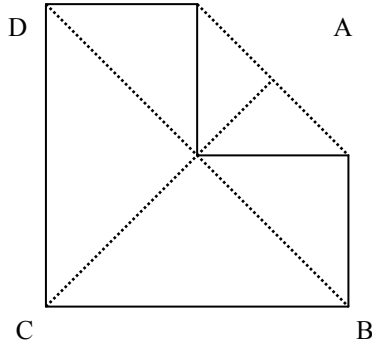


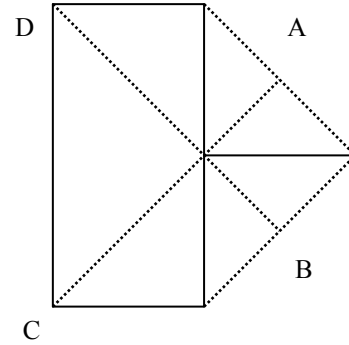
How to make a decorative box using recycled mail order catalogues



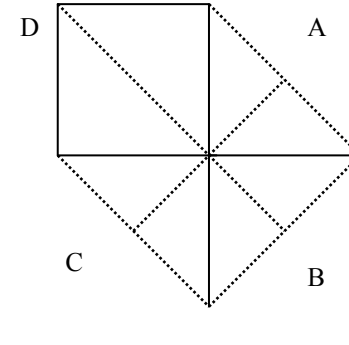
Fold square corner to corner then open out to find centre



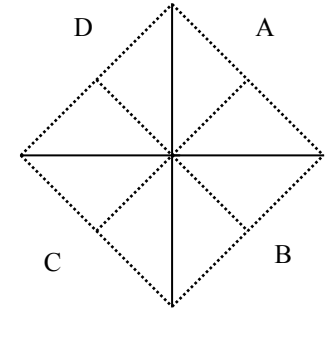
Fold corner A to centre



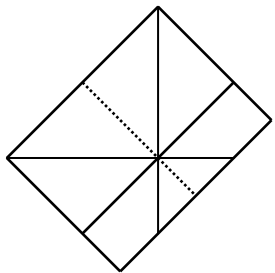
Fold corner B to centre



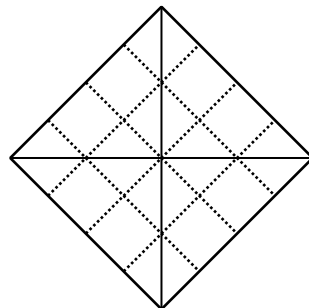
Fold corner C to centre



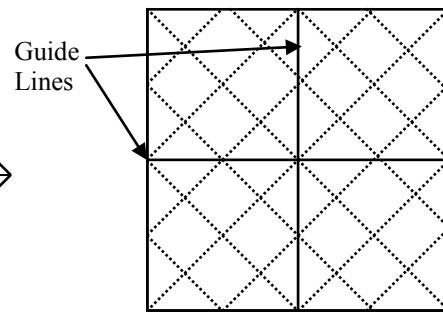
Fold corner D to centre



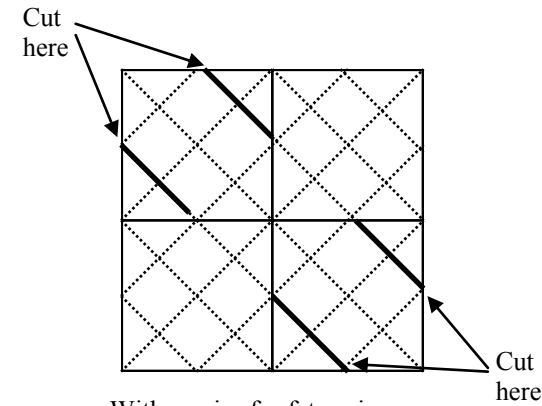
When all four corners have been folded into the centre fold each edge into the centre, crease firmly then open out



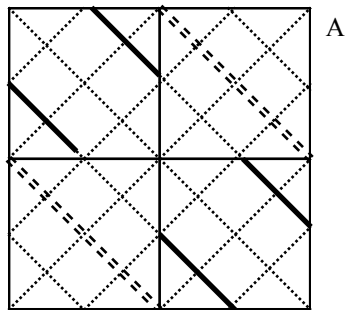
After each edge has been folded and creased you should be left with a pattern of creases like this.



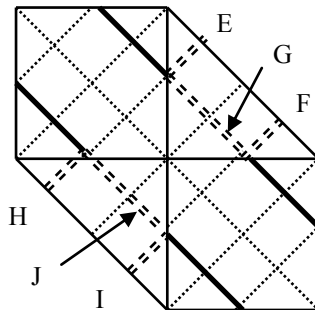
Open out entire square and you will see a pattern of creases as above



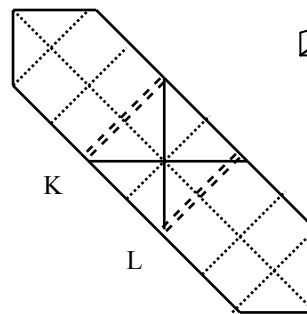
With a pair of safety scissors cut along the creases as shown



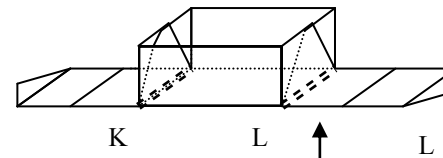
Fold corners A and C into the centre of the square and crease firmly



Firmly crease folds E, F and G. Fold along G leaving it upright so as to form one side of the box. Open out folds E and F to form another two sides of the box

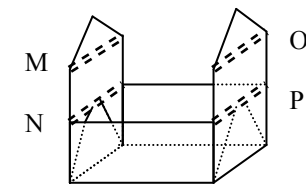


View of box from above

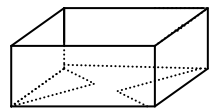


View from the side

Your box will look something like this



Fold along crease N and P over the sides of the box created by folds E, F and H, I. This will hold the sides in place. Finally fold creases M and O into the corners in the base of the box



The finished Box
